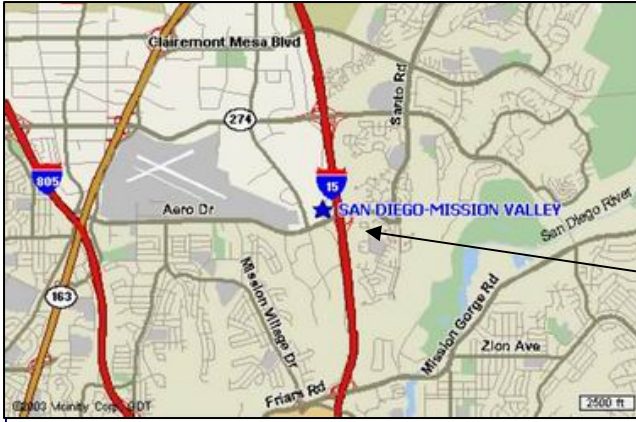

Legal departments need to define the policies for retention, disposition and discovery. IT departments must respond to strict requirements around the preservation of email and document files, and they need to be prepared to testify regarding the preservation and production of documents relevant to litigation matters.
